

Welfare of Stray Dogs (WSD) Foundation, Mumbai

1. The Need in the Community

The Welfare of Stray Dogs (WSD) Foundation in Mumbai is an NGO dedicated to addressing the challenges faced by stray dogs through vaccination, sterilization, rehabilitation, and educational campaigns promoting responsible pet ownership.
